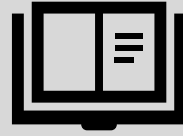

Proverbs 3:9-10 (NIV)

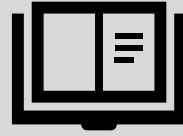
 **Take Note**
