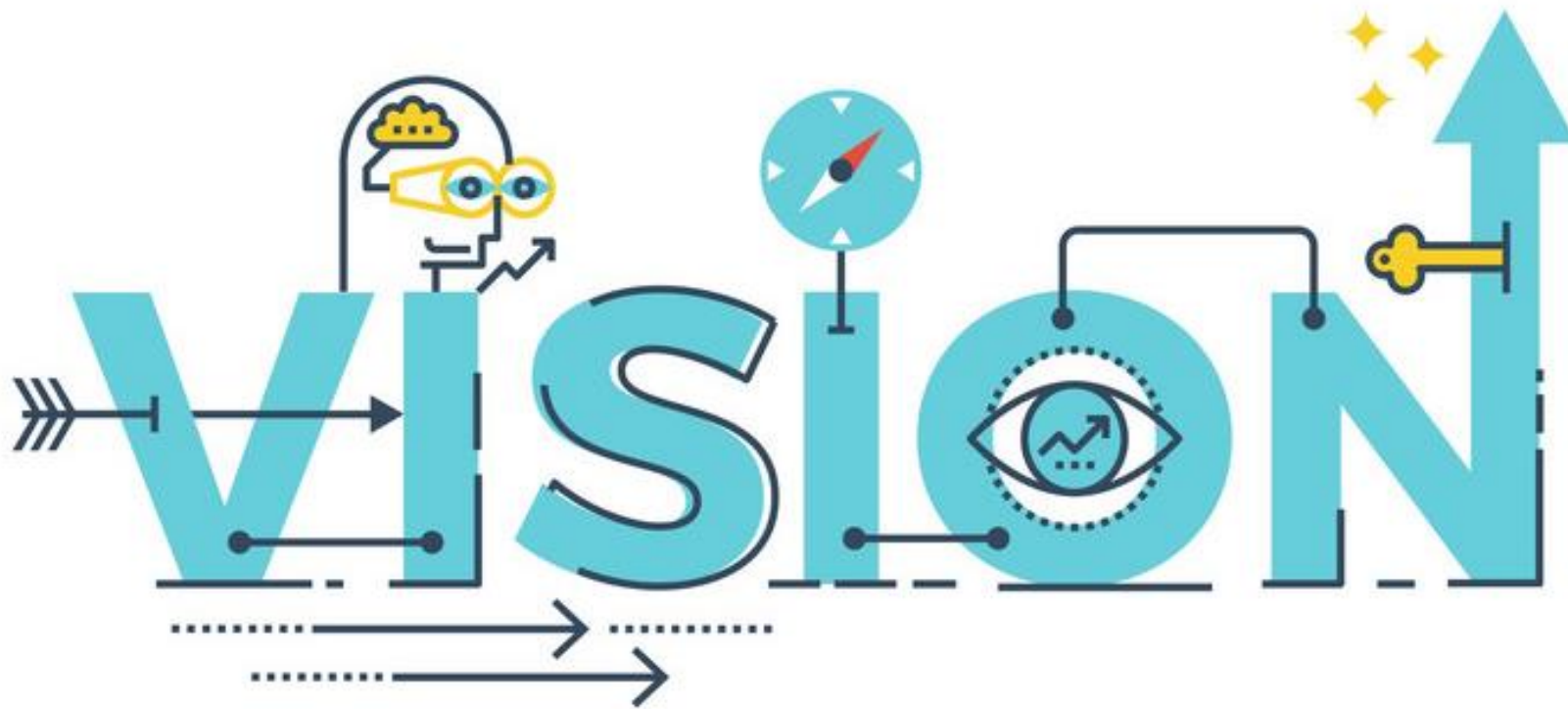

- 1. Receive authority from Jesus (v.18)**
- 2. Go share the GOSPEL CARD s to friends and family (v. 19)**
- 3. Disciple by starting FAITH GROUPS (v. 19)**
- 4. Promote the SUNDAY CELEBRATION SERVICES (v. 20)**
- 5. Encourage them to join the JUMP START and FAITHFUL WEEKEND (v. 20)**
- 6. Depend on the presence and power of the Holy Spirit (v. 20)**
